A spambot is an automatic program that will roam the web, "harvesting" email addresses from newsgroup postings and from other websites. It literally gathers thousands of

email addresses during a single hour. These are compiled into bulk mailing lists with which the spammers can mail thousands of victims at a time. The practise of sending out unsolicited, unwanted junk email and junk postings came to be called "spam." The term is usually believed to possess been derived from a British comedy skit by Monty Python, during which a restaurant serves each meal with a side of spam.
