First, we use clustering to model reviewers into different classes that reflect different skill levels to write a quality review such as expert, novice, etc. Through temporal analysis of reviewer behavior, we have found that reviewers evolve over time, with their reviews becoming better or worse in quality and more or less in quantity. We also investigate how reviews are valued differently across different product categories. Through machine learning-based classification techniques, we have found that, for products associated with prevention consumption goal, longer reviews are perceived to be more helpful; and, for products associated with promotion consumption goal, positive reviews are more helpful than negative ones. In this Thesis, our proposed review recommendation framework is aimed to help a novice or conscientious reviewer become an expert reviewer. Our assumption is that a reviewer will reach the highest level of expertise by learning from the experiences of his or her closest experts who have a similar evolutionary pattern to that of the reviewer who is being trained. In order to provide assistance with intermediate steps for the reviewer to grow from his or her current state to the highest level of expertise, we want to recommend the positive actions--that are not too far out of reach of the reviewer--and discourage the negative actions--that are within reach of the reviewer--of the reviewer's closest experts. Recommendations are personalized to fit the expertise level of reviewers, their evolution trend, and product category. Using the proposed review recommendation system framework we have found that for a random

reviewer, at least 80% of the reviews posted by closest experts were of higher quality than that of the novice reviewer.
